

BORNISE

Sam (30) and Beckie (15) are sisters separated not only by age but by life's experiences. Sam, confident on the surface, uses race car driving-a tribute to her late father-to hide her unresolved grief and relationship anxieties with her girlfriend Amanda. Beckie, isolated by bullying at school and retreating into video games, struggles with loneliness and the pain of losing a father she never really had. On their mom's birthday, during a heated family argument, their mother inadvertently makes a heartfelt wish with a magical necklace. Under the glow of the full moon, that wish is granted, and the sisters wake up in each other's bodies.



THE HEART OF THE STORY

Beckie, a 15-year-old introvert, is drowning in the pressure of high school. To her, this moment is everything-friendships, expectations, and the fear that if she messes up now, her future is doomed. She feels invisible and struggles to be herself.

Sam, at 30, is confident and outgoing, but she's running from adulthood. Love, commitment, and the fear of loss keep her from taking the next step in her relationship. After seeing her mother lose the love of her life, she's terrified of risking her heart.

When magic forces them to swap lives, they must confront their deepest fears: Beckie learns that high school isn't the end of the world—it's just one chapter. Sam realizes that love and commitment don't have to be scary if you're with the right person.

WHY THIS SHOW NEEDS TO BE TOLD?

This show isn't just about bodyswapping-it's about stepping into someone else's world, feeling their struggles, and learning from them. Through Sam and Beckie's journey, we ask:

If you could live in your sister's shoes for a day, would you?

If you could see someone else's
biggest problems up close,
would it change how you see
 your own?

Magic allows them to literally walk in each other's shoes, facing challenges they never thought they could handle. And as they grow stronger, they'll soon realize this was just the beginningbecause in Season 2, they'll be thrown into an even bigger challenge: a hidden magical society that threatens their world.

This show blends relatable emotions with an exciting, magical twist, making us laugh, cry, and reflect on our own fears. It's about family, growth, and the lessons we can only learn when we see life from a different perspective.

MAIN CHARACTERS



BECKIE (15)

PERSONALITY: SHY, SMART, AND SENSITIVE.

ARC: BATTLING SCHOOL BULLYING, LONELINESS, AND A PAINFUL LONGING FOR VALIDATION. HER BODY SWAP FORCES HER TO EXPERIENCE LIFE WITH NEWFOUND CONFIDENCE, PUSHING HER TO GROW BEYOND HER ISOLATION.

CONFLICT: STRUGGLES WITH THE IDEA OF RETURNING TO HER OLD SELF AND THE SAFETY OF HER SECLUDED WORLD VS. EMBRACING CHANGE AND SELF-EXPRESSION.





PERSONALITY:OUTGOING, SEEMINGLY SELF-ASSURED, AND DRIVEN-BUT INTERNALLY CONFLICTED.

ARC: USES RACE CAR DRIVING AS AN ESCAPE FROM UNRESOLVED GRIEF OVER HER FATHER'S DEATH AND INDECISION IN HER RELATIONSHIP WITH AMANDA.

CONFLICT: MUST LEARN THAT HER CONFIDENCE HIDES VULNERABILITY; SHE FACES THE CHALLENGE OF BEING TRUE TO HERSELF AS SHE NAVIGATES ADULT RESPONSIBILITIES, LOVE, AND CAREER.





ROLE: A LOVING MOTHER WITH A SECRET MAGICAL HERITAGE.

CONFLICT: TORN BETWEEN PROTECTING HER DAUGHTERS AND ALLOWING THEM TO GROW BY FACING THEIR CHALLENGES. SHE HOLDS THE KEY TO THE FAMILY'S MYSTICAL PAST, THOUGH SHE KEEPS IT HIDDEN UNTIL CIRCUMSTANCES FORCE HER TO REVEAL IT.



ROLE: A SKILLED, ENIGMATIC SORCERER WITH HIS OWN MOTIVES WHO BECOMES THE SISTERS' GUIDE INTO THE MAGICAL REALM.

CONFLICT: BALANCES MENTORING THE SISTERS WITH KEEPING THE DELICATE BALANCE OF MAGIC FROM FALLING INTO THE WRONG HANDS, PARTICULARLY AS SECRET SOCIETIES BEGIN TO TAKE INTEREST.

A medium-sized modern city, not too big to be overwhelming but not small enough for everyone to know each other's business. The mom's house is a cozy, medium-sized with a nice backyard but a slightly messy family house. The school is a regular public high school, while Sam's workplace is a sleek corporate marketing office. Their aunt, who knows about the family's mystical secrets, lives in a warm, eccentric house filled with artifacts, old books, and trinkets from different cultures.



SETUP

KEY MOMENTS

- Family tension at Angela's (mom) 50th birthday leads to a heated argument. Angela's inadvertent wish, combined with a magical necklace, triggers the body-swap under a full moon.
- Sam and Beckie wake up to the shocking reality of body swap; Didi's humorous yet confused introduction as narrator.



After mastering their own struggles in Season 1, Sam and Beckie discover that their body swap was just the beginning. A second magical event transports them to the **1800s**, the time of their **great-great-greatgrandmother**, who was part of an ancient mystical society.

In this forgotten world of secret magic, they must adapt to Victorian-era customs, navigate a world where women's roles are limited, and uncover the origin of their family's powers. But they soon realize that their ancestor was in the middle of a dangerous conflict-one that could rewrite history itself.


